

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

This study aimed to explore the effectiveness of using the Padlet application in improving the narrative writing skills of Grade X Senior High School students in English. The findings revealed that the experimental group, which utilized Padlet as a learning tool, showed a notable improvement in their writing skills compared to the control group, which followed traditional teaching methods. By analyzing the data using the N-Gain score, it was found that the majority of students in the experimental group achieved scores categorized as Enough Effective (56-75%) and Effective (>76%). This demonstrates that Padlet has a significant positive impact on students' writing performance.

Furthermore, the interactive and collaborative features of Padlet played a crucial role in enhancing students' narrative writing skills, particularly in areas such as plot development, character portrayal, vocabulary use, and overall language mechanics. The ability to share ideas, receive peer feedback, and engage in discussions through Padlet provided a more engaging learning experience compared to conventional methods. Based on these results, it can be concluded that Padlet is an effective tool for improving narrative writing skills among high school students, offering both an innovative and engaging approach to teaching English writing.

5.2 Suggestion

1. For Teachers

Teachers are encouraged to integrate digital tools like Padlet into their instructional practices to enhance students' engagement and learning outcomes. Padlet offers a versatile platform that supports interactive learning, enabling students to collaborate, organize ideas, and present their work creatively. Teachers should receive adequate training on how to effectively use Padlet and other digital tools to maximize their instructional potential. Additionally, combining Padlet with other teaching strategies, such as peer feedback and project-based learning, can further improve students' narrative writing skills.

2. For Students

Students are encouraged to actively use Padlet as a platform to improve their narrative writing skills. Through Padlet, students can express their ideas, share their work, and receive constructive feedback from peers and teachers. This collaborative approach not only enhances writing skills but also builds confidence and communication abilities. Students should take advantage of the multimedia features available in Padlet, such as uploading images, videos, and links, to make their narratives richer and more engaging. Consistent practice and participation in Padlet-based activities can lead to continuous improvement in their writing proficiency.
